



Create an Account


1. Sign up for an account



1. Sign up [here](#) and complete the registration form.



2. You will receive an activation email. Click the link to activate your account.




3. Set a password, add your mobile number, and agree to the Terms & Conditions



4. Click the Customer Hub icon to log in and proceed to linking your NGRs.


Note: We recommend signing up with your NGR primary user email to streamline linking your NGRs and more easily manage broker requests

2. Link your NGRs




1. Enter your NGR number and then select your NGR payee

Click the '+ Add' button to add additional NGRs and Request Access' to send the request.



2. The request is sent to the NGR Primary Contact for approval.

If that's you and you signed up with the same email address, the approval step will be automatic.




3. The NGR Primary contact will receive a verification email for all other users attempting to link the NGR in the Customer Hub


Set your notification preferences to determine which notifications you receive and in what format.


3. Set Notification Preferences



1. Open your account menu and Select 'Notification Preferences'




2. These are the ways you can receive notifications




3. Check or uncheck the boxes in the email and SMS tabs to set your preferences and click 'Save'


4. Locate Property with Farm Locator



1. Open your account menu and select 'Account Details'
Scroll down in the details to 'Your Farm Locations' and click the '+ Add new' button.



2. Enter 'Farm Name', select your 'NGR' and enter your Farm Address.



3. The coordinates will automatically populate. Click 'Save Location'.
